

General Provisions

1. Hygiene Guidelines

The competition will be held under the Corona regulations/guidelines/restrictions in force on the day of competition. An event-specific hygiene concept will be prepared for the event and published together with the hygiene rules in advance on the homepage of the Wasserfreunde Mühlacker 1920 e.V. (www.wasserfreunde-muehlacker.de/sendercup). The participating clubs incl. coaches, swimmers, and officials commit themselves to observe and comply with these. In case of non-compliance and fruitless reminders, the Wasserfreunde Mühlacker 1920 e.V. reserve the right to exclude individuals or the entire club. A refund of entry fees is excluded in this case.

2. CR/LR/ADR/Privacy Clause

The competition regulations (CR), the legal regulations (LR) and the anti-doping regulations (ADR) of the German Swimming Federation (DSV) apply. For handicapped individuals with corresponding proof of classification, additionally, the competition regulations of the National Paralympic Committee Germany (DBS) are to be applied. With the registration for participation in the competition and with the participation in the competition the club/swimmer declares that the competition regulations, the anti-doping regulations, and the legal regulations of the DSV are recognized and that they submit to them. By submitting the entries, the club declares that it and the registered athletes agree to the storage of personal data, and also to the publication of the competition data in the heat sheet, results, and regional rankings in paper form, and also electronically. The registering club also confirms that there are no objections to the publication of names and photos in the context of the coverage of this event. If this is not desired, it must be indicated in writing when submitting the entries.

3. Eligibility

The competition is open for all clubs of the German Swimming Federation (DSV) as well as for all foreign clubs, whose national swimming federation belongs to World Aquatics. Age groups 2016 and older are eligible to compete. In the order of events, the respective age group's eligibility to compete is indicated for each competition distance. Participants of age groups 2016 to 2014 are only allowed to compete a maximum of 6 events per day, including relays and finals.

4. Competition Pool

The competition pool is 50m long, has 8 lanes, and complies with DSV regulations. The lanes are separated from each other by wave killer lane lines. The water temperature is 24° C and the water depth is 3.80 - 1.90m. The one-start rule applies to the entire event. There will be electronic timekeeping with scoreboard.

Entries and Entry Cap

Please submit the entries on entry lists (Form 102) together with the entry form (Form 101), or as entry file in DSV standard by e-mail. Please provide an active e-mail address for the confirmation of receipt and the heat sheet. The organizer reserves the right to reject entries if the number of entries no longer allows the event to be run in a manner suitable for the competition. In this case the last received entries at the registration address will not be considered, i.e., the first-come-first-serve rule will be applied. In case of large volume of entries, the organizer reserves the right to change the session starting times. Notification will be given with the publication of the heat sheet. The 400m freestyle and 400m individual medley may be limited in the number of heats, two athletes may have to share one lane, or the events may be completely cancelled.

Entries must be received by the date mentioned above. Late entries will not be considered.

10. Accreditation

On the day of competition, the swimmers and coaches will get their accreditation at the entrance of the venue. Each registered participant, official, and coach will receive a participant ID card. This will be valid as a ticket for admission on the competition site.

11. Relays

Each mixed relay team must consist of two female and two male athletes. The order of athletes is left to the respective club.

12. Competition Categories

In individual events, age groups 2007 - 2016 will be judged by year, and age groups 2006 and older will be judged together. For relay events, there is a youth category (youth E+D | age groups 2013-2016), junior category (youth C+B | age groups 2009-2012) and an open category (youth A and older | age groups 2008 an earlier). The allocation to the relay classification depends on the oldest participant of the respective relay (e.g. 3x E-youth + 1x C-youth = classification junior C+B).

13. Qualification for Finals

The 8 fastest swimmers from 100m prelims, born in 2009 or older, will qualify for the Open Final. The Youth Final will be seeded with the 8 fastest swimmers born between 2010 and 2014.

The Youth Final for 200m individual medley will be seeded with the 8 fastest swimmers born between 2014 and 2012.

The corresponding announcement will be made during the competition with a 30-minute scratch period. Scratches must be made at the announcer's table.

14. Pursuit Race

The pursuit race will consist of the fastest respective athletes of the heats of each of the four 100m stroke events. The four remaining lanes will be filled with participants drawn by lot, one from all entries of each respective 100m event. The swimmer with the slowest prelim time starts with the regular start signal, while all other participants receive their start signal from the respective official with consideration of the time difference to the first swimmer. There will be separate pursuit races for men and women.

15. Awards

The top three finishers will receive medals. All participants will receive a certificate.

The top 3 finishes of the open 100m finals will receive prize money at the award ceremony as follows: 1st place: $50 ext{ } ext{€}$, 2nd place: $30 ext{€}$, 3rd place: $20 ext{€}$. The winners of the 100m youth finals will receive prize money as follows: 1st place: $25 ext{€}$ for, 2nd place: $25 ext{€}$, 3rd place: $15 ext{€}$. The top three finishers of the pursuit races will receive prize money at the award ceremony as follows: 1st place: $50 ext{€}$, 2nd place: $30 ext{€}$, 3rd place: $20 ext{€}$.

16. Seeding

The seeding of the heats and timed finals will be based on the entry times.

17. Officials

All registering clubs participate in proportion to their athletes in the officials' panel. The necessary number of officials will be announced with the heat sheet.

20. Catering

There will be catering. Please inform your athletes, coaches, and support staff in advance. Officials will be provided with beverages and food.

21. Pool Regulations

Tents may be set up on the marked areas of the competition site. Glass bottles are prohibited on the entire premises. The house rules of the outdoor pool Mühlacker apply.

22. Liability

The host team and the Freibad Mühlacker (outdoor swimming pool Mühlacker) are not liable for lost objects, for damages, or injuries. The instructions of the pool staff must be followed.
